APPLICATION

On August 25, 2016, Highlands Natural Resources Corporation, Operator No. 10625 ("Highlands" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Vacate an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-612 for Sections 34 and 35, Township 5 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation;
- 2) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve up to one horizontal well within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation;
- 3) Require the productive intervals of the wellbore of any permitted wells to be no closer than 600 feet from the eastern, northern and southern boundaries of the unit, no closer than 100 feet from the western boundary of the unit, no closer than 100 feet from the western boundary of the unit (regardless of the lease lines within the unit), and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well producing from the same formation, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

 Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. Section 34, Township 5 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M. is subject to this Rule for the Niobrara Formation.

On December 15, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-612 which established

 for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara
 Formation.
