- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Varra #6 Well (API No. 05-123-39989) (WSU #1), the Varra #7 Well (API No. 05-123-39987) (WSU #2), the Varra #8 Well (API No. 05-123-39988) (WSU #3), and the Varra #9 Well (API No. 05-123-39986) (WSU #4).
