On August 25, 2016, amended September 22, 2016, Synergy Resources Corporation, Operator No. 10311 ("Synergy" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Establish an approximate 560-acre drilling and spacing unit for Application Lands, and approve up to eight horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with the productive intervals of the wellbore of any permitted wells to be located not less than 75 feet from the east and west boundaries of the unit, and not less than 460 feet from the north and south boundaries of the unit, with an inter-well setback of not less than 150 feet from the productive interval of a well producing from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, without exception being granted by the Director.
