On August 25 2016, **amended November 4, 2016**, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying the 1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit comprising the Application Lands.
- 2) Providing that the Commission's pooling order be made effective as of the date of the Amended Application.
- 3) Providing that Applicant is not seeking cost recovery pursuant to §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., but has the right to seek retroactive cost recovery from non-consenting parties in compliance with Commission Rule 530 upon issuance of an order allowing for such cost recovery.

• On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A was amended to, among other things, address drilling of horizontal wells but did not prohibit the establishment of drilling and spacing units within the Greater Wattenberg Area. The lands encompassing the Application Lands are subject to Rule 318A, for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
