On September 8, 2016, Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation (Operator No. 96155) ("Whiting" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an 960-acre drilling and spacing unit covering the Application Lands as described below for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Dakota D-Sand Formation;
- 2) Approve up to a total of four (4) horizontal wells in the 960-acre drilling and spacing unit comprised of the Application Lands for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Dakota D-Sand Formation;
- 3) Require the productive interval of the wellbore of any permitted wells to be located no closer than 100 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 100 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in each unit; and
- 4) Applicant requests that the wells are drilled from no more than one well pad within the unit, unless the director grants an exception.

• Rule 318.a. provides that a well drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth shall be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same

source of supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule for the D-Sand Formation.
