NOTICE OF HEARING

APPLICATION

On October 11, 2016, Carrizo (Niobrara) LLC (Operator No. 10439), a subsidiary of Carrizo Oil & Gas, Inc. ("Carrizo" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1.) Pool all interests in an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2.) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of § 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Shull 2-25-9-60 Well (API No. 05-123-37245), Shull 3-25-9-60 Well (API No. 05-123-37244), and Shull 4-25-9-60 Well (API No. 05-123-37243).

- On February 22, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-3 which established approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands, including the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, and approved one horizontal well within each unit, with the initial perforation of Niobrara Formation and ultimate bottom hole location no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the unit.
- On February 11, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 535-265 which approved up to six horizontal wells within certain exploratory drilling and spacing units, including the drilling and spacing unit comprising the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

- On February 11, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 535-287 which pooled all interests in certain lands, including the Application Lands, to accommodate the Shull 1-25-9-60 Well, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- On December 16, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 535-437 which approved an additional 8 horizontal wells, for a total of up to 14 horizontal wells in the Application Lands for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- On December 15, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-583 which approved an additional two horizontal wells, for a total of up to 16 horizontal wells in the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of January 13, 2017.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
