1.) Establish an approximate 160-acre drilling and spacing unit upon the Application Lands with the well to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, without exception granted by the Director.

Commission Rule 318.a. for unspaced lands provides that a well to be drilled in excess

hundred (600) feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than one thousand
two hundred (1,200) feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling
to the same source of supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon
hearing. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule for the Niobrara Formation.
