APPLICATION

On October 13, 2016, Noble Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 100322) ("Noble" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order:

- 1) Partially vacating Order Nos. 535-3 and 535-271 as they apply to the Application Lands, providing, however, that Order No. 535-3 shall remain applicable to the KRIER GV 25-62HN (API No. 05-123-34344) on the Application Lands.
- 2) Establishing an approximate 1,280 acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 24 and 25, Township 9 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M., and allowing up to two (2) horizontal wells within the unit to efficiently and economically develop and recover the oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations in the unit.
- 3) Providing that the treated interval of any horizontal well shall be no closer than 200 feet from the northern boundary of the unit and 600 feet from the eastern, southern and western boundaries of the unit, and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well within the unit, and authorizing up to one (1) well pad to be located on the unit or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 4) Finding that an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the development of the Codell and Niobrara Formations on the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Codell and Niobrara Formations in Sections 24 and 25, Township 9 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M.
- 5) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On February 22, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-3, which among other things, approves the request for an order to establish two (2) approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for the Application Lands, and to drill one horizontal well in each of the units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the initial perforation and the ultimate bottomhole location being no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the drilling and spacing unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- On March 25, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 535-271, which among other things, vacated two approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units established by Order No. 535-3 for Sections 23 and 24, Township 9 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M., and established an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and to drill one horizontal well within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formation, with the treated interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, without exception being granted by the Director.
