- On May 16, 2011, the Commission entered order 535-69 which, among other things established various approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands including Section 30, Township 8 North, Range 59 West, and approved up to two horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
