APPLICATION LANDS

Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M. Section 6: All

APPLICATION

On October 13, 2016, ConocoPhillips Company ("Conoco" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order:

- 1) Vacating an approximate 1280-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-519 for Sections 5 and 6, Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- 2) Establishing an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for Section 6, Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., and allowing up to one (1) horizontal well in the unit in order to efficiently and economically develop and recover the oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from of the Niobrara Formation in the unit.
- 3) Providing that the treated interval any horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well within the unit, and authorizing up to one (1) well pad in the unit, or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 4) Finding that an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the development of the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Niobrara Formation in Section 6, Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M.
- 5) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On November 29, 2011, effective October 31, 2011, the Commission entered Order No., 535-97, which established 25 approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands located in Townships 4 and 5 South, Ranges 64 and 65 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to two horizontal wells within each unit, with surface locations being located anywhere within the unit or surrounding lands but the lateral of such well may not enter the Niobrara Formation any closer than 300 feet from the section line, with the treated interval of the permitted wellbore to be located no closer than 460 feet from the boundary of the unit and no closer than 920 feet from the treated interval of any other well in the unit producing from the Niobrara Formation, without exception being granted by the Director, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- On August 13, 2014, effective as of July 28, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-519, which vacated two (2) approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units established by Order No. 535-97 for Sections 5 and 6, Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., and established an approximate 1280-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit for Sections 5 and 6, Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., and approving a total of up to two (2) horizontal wells with the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 960 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
