### **APPLICATION**

On December 1, 2016, WPX Energy Production, LLC (Operator No. 96705) ("Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1160-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Mancos Formation;
  - 2) Approve up to thirteen horizontal wells within the unit;
- 3) Require the treated interval of any horizontal wellbore to be located no less than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and not less than 250 feet from the treated interval of any other well within the unit, including the existing vertical well; and
- 4) Require the wells be drilled from no more than two well pads within the unit, without exception by the Director.

Commission Rule 318.a. for unspaced lands provides that a well to be drilled in excess
of two thousand five hundred feet in depth shall be located not less than six hundred feet
from any lease line, and shall be located not less than one thousand two hundred feet
from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same source of
supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing.
