APPLICATION

On December 1, 2016, ConocoPhillips Company (Operator No. 19160) ("Conoco" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit comprising the Application Lands.
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the State Bierstadt 4-65 35-34 4BH (API No. pending) and the State Bierstadt 4-65 35-34 4AH (API No. Pending) to the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.

- On October 24, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 535-740 which, among other things, established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands and approved up to two (2) horizontal wells within the drilling and spacing unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the productive interval of the wellbore of each well to be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
