APPLICATION

On December 1, 2016, PDC Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 69175) ("PDC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 480-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing unit, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Ehrlich 5M-243 well (API No. 05-123-43547) ("Well").

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formations, the Codell Formation, and the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands, including the Application Lands, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On July 11, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 407-641, which, among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in a 160-acre drilling and spacing unit for the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. for the Jurgens PC B08-22D well (API No. 05-123-34966), from the Codell-Niobrara formation.

Order No. 407-641 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.

- On January 8, 2015, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1182, which among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in a 160-acre drilling and spacing unit for the SW¼ of Section 5, Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. for the LDS B05-25 well (API No. 05-123-34204), from the Codell and Niobrara Formations. Order No. 407-1182 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.
