<u>APPLICATION</u>

On December 1, 2016 (amended January 19, 2017), Fifth Creek Energy Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10629) ("Fifth Creek" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit comprising the Application Lands.
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Fox Creek 223-3422H Well (API No. 05-123-42580) to the Codell and Niobrara Formations on the Application Lands.

- On February 22, 2010, the Commission entered Order 421-1 which, among other things, established 58 approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units, including the Application Lands, approving no more than one horizontal well within each of the units, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- On January 7, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 421-17 which, among other things, vacated two approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units established by Order No. 421-1 for Sections 22 and 27, Township 12 North, Range 63 West, 6th P.M., and establish an approximate 1265-acre stand-up exploratory drilling and spacing unit for Sections 22 and 27, Township 12 North, Range 63 West, 6th P.M., and approve up to ten wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

- On January 26, 2015 (amended April 13, 2015), the Commission entered Order No. 421-57 which, among other things, established 11 approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing units, including the Application Lands, approving one horizontal well within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation.
- On July 20, 2015, the Commission entered Order No. 421-64 which, among other things, modified Order No. 421-57 to allow for a total of up to six horizontal wells within each unit, including the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation, with the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director.
