APPLICATION

On December 1, 2016, Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP, Operator No. 47120 ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in two approximate 1,040-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units and one approximate 1,000-acre horizontal wellbore spacing unit, established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation; and

2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Hopper State 9N-34SLHZ Well (API No. 05-123-43021) (WSU #1), the Hopper State 24N-34SLHZ Well (API No. 05-123-43024) (WSU #2), and the Hopper State 40N-34SLHZ Well (API No. 05-123-43025) (WSU #3).
