#### **APPLICATION**

On or before January 19, 2017, Great Western Operating Company, LLC ("Great Western" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order:

- 1) Approving up to twelve (12) wells in order to efficiently and economically recover the oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations in an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 407-1778 the Application Lands.
- 2) Providing that the surface locations for the additional wells shall be located on no more than one pad location within the unit or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 3) Providing that the treated interval of the wellbores shall be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries and no closer than 150 feet from the treated interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director.
- 4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

 On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
- On August 29, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1778 which, among other things, established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit and approved up to ten (10) horizontal wells within the unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations on the Application Lands, providing that the productive interval of the wellbore shall be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore in the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director, and further providing that the proposed wells shall be located on no more than one well pad within the drilling and spacing unit, subject to Rule 318A, unless the Director grants and exception.

Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
