APPLICATION

On January 19, 2017, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 1,087-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and

2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the following wells: Broe FD 34-059HNX, Broe FD 34-059HN, Broe FD 34-099HN, Broe FD 34-099HC, Broe FD 34-102HNX, Broe FD 34-102HN, Broe FD 34-142HC, Broe FD 34-142HN, Broe FD 34-179HN, Broe FD 34-222HN, Broe FD 34-222HNX, Broe FD 34-259HC, Broe FD 34-259HN, Broe FD 34-299HN, Broe FD 34-299HNX, Broe FD 34-302HC, Broe FD 34-302HN, Broe FD 34-342HN, Broe FD 34-342HNX and the Broe FD 34-379HC ("Wells").

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara

Formations underlying certain lands, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.

- On December 12, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1833 which, among other things, established an approximate 1,087-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands in portions of Sections 34 and 35, Township 6 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to 20 horizontal wells within the new unit for the efficient and economic production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, providing that there will be no more than one (1) new well pad in the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director, and providing that the productive interval of each wellbore shall be no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore producing from the Niobrara or Codell Formations and no closer than 460 feet from a unit boundary.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of March 6, 2017.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
