APPLICATION

On January 19, 2017, Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP (Operator No. 47120) ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116 C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in two approximate 240-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units and five approximate 480-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of § 34-60-116(7), C.R.S. effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the drilling of the Camenisch 29C-35HZ well (API No. 05-123-43338), the Camenisch 29N-35HZ well (API No. 05-123-43342), the Camenisch 4N-35HZ well (API No. 05-123-43340), the Camenisch 30N-35HZ well (API No. 05-123-43343), the Camenisch 3C-35HZ well (API No. 05-123-43339), the Camenisch 4C-35HZ well (API No. 05-123-43344), and the Camenisch 3N-35HZ well (API No. 05-123-43341).

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of March 6, 2017.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
