On February 2, 2017, Synergy Resources Corporation, Operator No. 10311 ("Synergy" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1,039.492-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve up to 20 horizontal wells within the proposed unit, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations;
- 2) Require the productive intervals of the wellbores to be no closer than 150 feet from the eastern and western boundaries of the proposed unit and no closer than 460 feet to the northern and southern boundaries of the proposed unit, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore within the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 3) Applicant states that any horizontal wells to be drilled in the unit will be drilled from no more than two multi-well pads on the surface of the drilling unit, or on adjacent lands with consent of the landowner, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
