On January 27, 2017, Bison Oil & Gas, LLC (Operator No. 10618) ("Bison" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Amend Order No. 535-738 to approve up to 12 horizontal wells within an established 960-acre drilling and spacing unit comprised of the Application Lands for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Applicant states that the wells shall be drilled from no more than three well pads within the unit, or from a legal location on adjacent lands.

On August 29, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 535-738, which established a 960-acre drilling and spacing unit covering the Application Lands and approved up to three horizontal wells within the unit for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the productive interval of the wellbore of any permitted wells to be located no closer than 300 feet from the unit boundaries and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit without exception being granted by the Director. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.
