## <u>APPLICATION</u>

On March 3, 2017, Ward Petroleum Corporation, Operator No. 10359 ("Ward" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 480-acre drilling and spacing unit for the SW¼ of Section 1 and the W½ of Section 12, Township 1 South, Range 68 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., and approve up to 12 horizontal wells within the unit, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and
- 2) Require the productive intervals of the wellbore to be located no closer than 460 feet from unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 3) Applicant states that the proposed wells will be located on no more than one multi-well pad within the unit, subject to Rule 318A, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
