### <u>APPLICATION</u>

On April 13, 2017, Carrizo Oil & Gas, Inc. (Operator No. 10338) and Carrizo (Niobrara) LLC (Operator No. 10439) (together, "Carrizo" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-116, for an Order to:

- 1) Amend Order No. 535-476 to include the Codell formation in the approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit previously established for the Application Lands;
- 2) Approve the development of a maximum of 16 horizontal wells for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations on the Application Lands;
- 3) Provide that the productive interval of any wellbore shall be no closer than 300 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore producing from the Niobrara Formation or the Codell Formation, and no closer than 300 feet from the exterior boundaries of the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director; and
- 4) Provide that the wells shall be drilled from no more than four well pads located on the Application lands, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

 On March 28, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 535-267, which, among other things, established an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit for all of Section 21 and the N½ of Section 28, Township 11 North, Range 57 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara formation, and approved up to four horizontal wells within the unit.

• On May 16, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-476, which, among other things, vacated the approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit inclusive of Section 28, Township 11 North, Range 57 West, 6th P.M., established by Order No. 535-267, and established an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit for All of Section 28 and the E½ of Section 29, Township 11 North, Range 57 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, and approved up to 16 horizontal wells within the unit.
