APPLICATION

On April 13, 2017, Noble Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 100322) ("Noble" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 675.97-acre horizontal wellbore spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Shadow A26-656 Well (API No. 05-123-42881) (the "Well").

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formations, the Codell Formation, and the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands, including the Application Lands, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.

- On March 5, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 407-566 which, among other things, established an approximate 320-acre wellbore spacing unit to accommodate the Scholfield State A36-69HN Well (API No. 05-123-33320) for the production of the Codell and Niobrara Formations on certain portions of the Application Lands. Order No. 407-566 is noted for the Commission's reference but is not applicable to this Application.
- On September 14, 2015, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1447 which, among other things, pooled all interests in an approximate 711.92-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing unit established for portions of the Application Lands for the development of the Codell Formation. Order No. 407-1447 is noted for the Commission's reference but is not applicable to this Application.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of May 26, 2017.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
