APPLICATION

On May 25, 2017 (Amended on June 13, 2017), Laramie Energy, LLC (Operator No. 10433) ("Laramie" or "Applicant"), filed a verified Application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the approximate 323.72-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 369-14 for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations; and
- 2) Subject nonconsenting or unleased interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application or the date the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the new 18 Bruton Wells.

- On May 18, 2015, the Commission entered Order No. 369-14 which established the Application Lands as an approximate 323.72-acre drilling and spacing unit with the equivalent of one well per 10-acre density for all wells producing within the unit and directed that wells within the Application Lands be located no closer than 100 feet from the unit boundary line, or 200 feet from the unit boundary line if the unit abuts or corners lands not subject to 10-acre density, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 10, 2017.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
