On July 11, 2017, Great Western Operating Company, LLC ("Great Western" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 895.11-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve up to 24 horizontal wells in the unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations;
- 2) Provide that the productive interval any horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well within the unit, and approve up to three well pads within or adjacent to the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
