On July 13, 2017, Bill Barrett Corporation (Operator No. 10071) ("BBC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Section 30, Township 1 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., and Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., and approve up to 16 horizontal wells in the unit, for the production of the oil and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- 2) Require that the productive interval of any horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and not less than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well within the unit:
- 3) Applicant states that the wells permitted under this Order shall be located on no more than four new well pads within the unit, subject to Rule 318A, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 4) Applicant also requests any such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable.

On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
