APPLICATION

On July 13, 2017, Bison Oil & Gas II, LLC (Operator No. 10661) ("Bison" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Vacate two approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units established by Order No. 535-3 for Section 5 and 6, Township 8 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M., for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation;
- 2) Establish an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve up to 20 horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Ft. Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations; and
- 3) Require the productive interval of the wellbore of each wellbore in the unit to be no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundary, and no closer than 100 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located within the drilling and spacing unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 4) Applicant states that the wells be drilled from no more than three (3) well pads located within the unit, without exception granted by the Director.

 Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. On March 8, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-3, which established 160 approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands in Townships 8, 9, and 10, North, Ranges 58 through 61 West, 6th P.M., and approved one horizontal well in each unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the treated interval of the wellbores to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, without exception being granted by the Director.

Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
