On July 13, 2017, Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP (Operator No. 47120) ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116 C.R.S. for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in pool all interests in two approximate 400-acre wellbore spacing units established for the Application Lands, for the drilling of the Newby State 26N-33HZ well (API No. 05-123-44565), and the Newby State 30N-34HZ well (API No. 05-123-44563), for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations.

- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.


Additional information about the hearing on this Application will be in the Commission's Agenda, which is posted on the Commission website approximately 3 days before the hearing.
