APPLICATION

On July 13, 2017, Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. (Operator No. 10459) ("Extraction" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Vacate Order Nos. 407-1790, 407-1828, 407-1829, and 407-1830;
- 2) Establish an approximate 1,920-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, and approve up to twenty horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and
- 3) Require the productive interval of the wellbore of any permitted wells in the unit to be located no closer than 150 feet from the treated interval of any other wellbore producing from the Codell and/or Niobrara formations, and no closer than 460 feet from the southern and western unit boundaries and 150 feet from the northern and eastern unit boundaries, without exception being granted by the Director.
- 4) Applicant states that the wells will be drilled from one well pad located in the unit and/or from a legal location on adjacent lands, without exception granted by the Director, and that all horizontal wells will be drilled in a north-south orientation.

- On October 24, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1829, which established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the E½ of Sections 3 and 10, Township 1 South, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to 10 horizontal wells within the unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations. The E½ of Section 10 of Application Lands is subject to this Order for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- On October 24, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1830, which established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the W½ of Sections 15 and 22, Township 1 South, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to 10 horizontal wells within the unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations. The W½ of Sections 15 and 22 of Application Lands is subject to this Order for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
