On July 13, 2017, Incline Niobrara Partners, LP ("INP" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S. ("Application"), for an order:

- 1) Vacating Commission Order No. 407-1547 in Docket No. 151200690, dated December 8, 2015 ("Order 407-1547") based upon the failure of the applicant therein to meet the jurisdictional standing requirements of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Act and Commission Rules:
- 2) In the alternative, amending Order No. 407-1547 to provide that: (i) INP is not a non-consenting party with respect to the drilling, completion and operation of 19 horizontal wells within the Application Lands, such that the interests of INP in the Application Lands are not subject to the pooling, cost recovery and penalty provisions of § 34-60-116, C.R.S. and (ii) requiring the operator of such 19 horizontal wells to comply with the provisions of § 34-60-116, C.R.S. and Commission Rule 530 as to INP.

On December 8, 2015, the Commission issued Order No. 407-1547 in Docket No. 151200690, Cause No. 407, establishing the Application Lands as a 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of Codell-Niobrara Formation hydrocarbon, authorizing the drilling, completion and operation of up to 19 horizontal wells within the same, pooling all interests within the same, and subjecting the interests of nonconsenting parties to the cost recovery and penalty provisions of § 34-60-116, C.R.S.
