Providing that the interests of any owners within the Additional Lands with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Bestway 14-2-11-14NAHZM Well and the Bestway B-2-11-14NBHZM Well, are made subject to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Bestway 14-2-11-14NAHZM Well and the Bestway B-2-11-14NBHZM Well.
