APPLICATION

On September 27, 2017, Ward Petroleum Corporation (Operator No. 10359) ("Ward" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in a 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and

2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Schaefer 2413-3-15HN Well (API No. 05-001-09860) and the Schaefer 2413-3-11HC Well (API No. 05-001-09801) ("Wells").

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On March 20, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1905, which established a 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 13 and 24, Township 1 South, Range 67 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., and authorized the drilling of up to 23 horizontal wells in such unit to the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with the producing interval of the wellbores located no closer than 460-feet from the unit boundaries and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit without exception being granted by the Director of the Commission.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of November 27, 2017, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
