APPLICATION

On October 12, 2017, SRC Energy Inc., Operator No. 10311 ("SRC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1440-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations;
- 2) Approve the drilling of 20 horizontal wells in the proposed unit, to be drilled in a general east/west orientation, and
- 3) Allow the treated intervals of the wellbores to be no closer than 150 feet from the western boundary and not less than 460 feet from the remaining unit boundaries of the proposed unit, and the inter-well setbacks should be no closer than 150 feet from the treated interval of a well producing from the same formation.
- 3) Applicant states that any horizontal wells to be drilled in the unit will be drilled from no more than two multi-well pads on the surface of the drilling unit, or on adjacent lands with consent of the landowner, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
