APPLICATION

On October 12, 2017, amended October 26, 2017, PDC Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 69175) ("PDC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in four approximate 320-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara formations; and
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the Wiedeman Federal 22H-212 well (API No. 05-123-43390), Wiedeman Federal 22H-302 Well (API No. 05-123-43397), and Wiedeman Federal 22H-232 Well (API No. 05-123-43394) ("Wells").

APPLICABLE RULES AND ORDERS

- Rule 318A, as amended on August 8, 2011 addresses the drilling of horizontal wells under Rule 318A.a.(4)D. Rule 318A was originally established on April 27, 1998 to allow for certain drilling locations to drill or twin an existing well, deepen a well, or recomplete a well. Rule 318A also provided for the commingling of any or all of the Cretaceous Age formations from the Dakota formation to the surface. Rule 318A was first amended on December 5, 2005 to allow for interior infill and boundary wells and spacing units.
- On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara formations, the Codell formation, and the Niobrara formation underlying certain lands, including the Application Lands, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order 407-1.
- On April 11, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 407-971, which, among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in a 405-acre wellbore spacing unit for the SE½SE½ of Section 22, SW½SW¼ of Section 23, W½W½ of Section 26, and E½E½ of Section 27, Township 4 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M., for the Peppler K26-79-1HN well (API No. 05-123-38236), from the Niobrara formation. Order No. 407-971 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Wells.

Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
