On October 12, 2017, Renegade Oil & Gas Company, LLC (Operator No. 74165) ("Renegade" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Amend Order Nos. 535-846 and 535-847 to require that the productive interval of the permitted horizontal wells within the established 640-acre drilling and spacing units covering the Application Lands (DSU No. 1 and DSU No. 2) be located no closer than 150 from the productive interval of any other horizontal wellbore within the unit producing oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation and be located no closer than 300 feet from the unit boundary, without exception being granted by the Director.
