On October 27, 2017, Mull Drilling Company, Inc. (Operator No. 61250) ("Mull" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-118, C.R.S., and Commission 400-Series Rules for an order to:

- 1) Approve the approximate 1040-acre unit ("Quiver Unit") established for the Application Lands, for the purpose of unit development and the enhanced recovery of hydrocarbons from the Mississippi St. Louis Formation and the Mississippi Spergen Formation ("Target Formations"); and
- 2) Authorize operations for the Quiver Unit pursuant to the Unit Agreement and the Unit Operating Agreement.

- On May 1, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 560-1 which established an approximate 1040-acre unit for the Application Lands, for the purpose of unit development and the enhanced recovery of hydrocarbons from the Target Formations for the Unit Area pursuant to § 34-60-118 C.R.S. and the Commission's 400 Series Rules and to authorize operations for the Quiver Unit pursuant to the Unit Agreement and the Unit Operating Agreement.
- Rule 401.a provides that no person shall perform any enhanced recovery operations, cycling or recycling operations including the extraction and separation of liquid hydrocarbons from natural gas in connection therewith, or operations for the storage of

gaseous or liquid hydrocarbons, nor shall any person carry on any other method of unit or cooperative development or operation of a field or a part of either, without having first obtained written authorization from the Commission to perform the aforementioned activities or operations.
