- On March 20, 2017, the Commission issued Order No. 407-1908, which established an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit covering Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 66 West, 6th, P.M., and the S½ of Section 34, Township 1 North Range 66 West, 6th P.M., and approved a total of 24 horizontal wells for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- On March 20, 2017, the Commission issued Order No. 407-1911, which pooled all
 interests in the approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No.
 407-1908 for the development and production of the Codell and Niobrara Formations and
 subjected all nonconsenting owners to the cost recovery provisions of Section 34-60116(7), C.R.S. for the Homestead 1 through 24 wells.
