On November 30, 2017, Ward Petroleum Corporation (Operator No. 10359) ("Ward" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Approve an additional six horizontal wells, for a total of up to 12 horizontal wells, in the 320-acre drilling and spacing unit composed of the Application Lands.
- 2) Require the productive intervals of the wellbores to be located no closer than 460 feet from unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 3) Applicant states that the proposed wells will be located on no more than one multiwell pad within or without the unit, subject to Rule 318A, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On June 20, 2016, the Commission entered Order 407-1709 which established the Application Lands as an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit and authorized the drilling of up to six horizontal wells for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell or Niobrara Formations.
