APPLICATION

On January 10, 2018, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 13 and 24, Township 1 South, Range 68 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. with one horizontal well to develop and recover the oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell, Carlile and Niobrara Formations in the unit;
- 2) Approve an additional 25 horizontal wells in the proposed unit, for a total of up to 26 horizontal wells in the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell, Carlile and Niobrara Formations;
- 3) Provide that the productive interval of any horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit and not less than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well within the unit, and authorize one well pad to be located adjacent to the proposed unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director; and
- 4) Find that an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the development of the Codell, Carlile and Niobrara Formations on the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Codell, Carlile and Niobrara Formations on the Application Lands.
- 5) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations underlying certain lands, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.

One electronic ([cogcc.hearings\\_unit@state.co.us](mailto:cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us)), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of March 5, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
