NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

APPLICATION LANDS

Township 6 South, Range 97 West, 6th P.M.
Section 3: All (Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, S½)

APPLICATION

On January 18, 2018, Laramie Energy, LLC (Operator No. 10433) ("Laramie" or "Applicant"), filed a verified Application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Vacate Commission Order No. 515-69 and establish an approximate 870.76-acre, more or less, drilling and spacing unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde Group, which includes the Williams Fork and Iles Formations, which includes, or whose members are, the Cameo, Rollins, Cozzette and Corcoran (collectively, the "Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group") and approve the equivalent of one well per 10-acre density for all wells producing from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group on the Application Lands, unless an exception is granted by the Director;

2) All wells producing from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group shall be located no closer than 100 feet from the exterior boundaries of the Application Lands, or 200 feet from the exterior boundaries of the Application Lands if the Application Lands abut or corner lands not subject to 10-acre density, unless an exception is granted by the Director; and

3) The wells subject to this Application will be drilled from lands outside the Application Lands or from no more than one well pad per quarter-quarter section within the Application Lands, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

- Order No. 510-15 authorized the equivalent of 10-acre density for wells drilled to and producing from the Williams Fork Formation underlying the Application Lands and other nearby lands.

- Order No. 510-48 authorized the equivalent of 10-acre density for wells drilled to and producing from the Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group underlying the Application Lands and other nearby lands.
- Order No. 510-69 established Lots 5 and 6 of the Application Lands as an approximate 115.37-acre drilling and spacing unit subject to the equivalent of 10-acre density for wells drilled to and producing from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of March 5, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
