APPLICATION

On January 18, 2018, Nickel Road Operating, LLC (Operator No. 10669), together with Nickel Road FW, LLC, an affiliate of Nickel Road Operating, LLC under common ownership and control (together, "Nickel Road" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 16 and 17, Township 7 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., and allowing up to 24 new horizontal wells in the unit in order to efficiently and economically develop and recover the Codell and Niobrara Formations in the unit;
- 2) Provide that the productive interval of each proposed horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet on the boundaries of the proposed unit, and all horizontal wells shall be no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well producing from the same supply within the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director and authorize that no more than two new well pads be authorized in the unit, or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 3) Find that the approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the development of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations underlying the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- 4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

APPLICABLE ORDERS AND RULES

- Rule 318.a. provides that "a well to be drilled two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet or
 greater shall be located not less than six hundred (600) feet from any lease line, and
 shall be located not less than one thousand two hundred (1,200) feet from any other
 producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply,
 unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing." The Application Lands are
 subject to Rule 318.a.
- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
