NOTICE OF HEARING

APPLICATION

On January 18, 2018 (amended February 7, 2018), Longs Peak Resources, LLC, Operator No. 10611 ("LPR" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Codell, Carlile and Fort Hays Formations; and authorize up to six horizontal wells for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell, Carlile and Fort Hays Formations, and up to seven horizontal wells for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation;
- 2) Amend, modify or vacate the 640-acre exploratory drilling units established by Order No. 535-10, only as to Sections 11 and 14, Township 11 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., so as to ensure no additional wells are drilled pursuant to Order No. 535-10 in the Application Lands, that the Wagner #11-65 11-1H Well (API No. 05-123-33110) located in Section 11, Township 11 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., remain the only well drilled pursuant to Order No. 535-10 in the Application Lands, and production from the Wagner #11-65 11-1H Well continue to be allocated on a 640-acre basis.
 - 3) Providing that setbacks for the Application Lands be as follows:
- a. Any horizontal wells to be drilled for production from the Niobrara, Codeli, Carlile and Fort Hays Formations will be drilled from the surface of the drilling unit, or on adjacent lands with consent of the landowner, from no more than four surface locations, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

- b. The wellbores of any horizontal wells to be drilled may enter the Niobrara, Codell, Carlile and Fort Hays Formations anywhere within the unit, or on adjacent lands, without exception being granted by the Director.
- c. For any permitted wells to be drilled for production from the Niobrara, Codell, Carlile and Fort Hays Formations, the treated intervals of the wells shall be not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well producing from the same unit, without exception being granted by the Director.
- d. For any permitted wells to be drilled for production from the Niobrara, Codell, Carlile and Fort Hays Formations, the productive interval of any permitted well shall be located no closer than 300 feet from the unit boundary.

APPLICABLE ORDERS AND RULES

- Rule 318.a. of the Commission Rules provides a well to be drilled 2,500 feet or greater shall be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply, unless authorized by the Commission upon hearing. The Application Lands are subject to Rule 318.a. for the Niobrara, Codell, Carlile and Fort Hays Formations.
- On April 4, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-10, which among other things, established two approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for Sections 11 and 14, Township 11 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., and approved one horizontal well within each unit, for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
