On January 18, 2018, Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. (Operator No. 10459) ("Extraction" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 1,360-acre drilling and spacing unit covering the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations;
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the: Coyote Trails 34S-20-10N Well (API No. 05-123-45994); Coyote Trails 34S-20-11C Well (API No. 05-123-45991); Coyote Trails 34S-20-12N Well (API No. 05-123-45983); Coyote Trails 34S-20-13N Well (API No. 05-123-45993); Coyote Trails 34S-20-16N Well (API No. 05-123-45990).

 On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.

- On October 24, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1794 which established one approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 28 and 33, Township 1 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to a total of 20 horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- On October 24, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1825 which established one approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for the W½ of Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to a total of 10 horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- On October 24, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1826 which established one approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for Section 4, Township 1 South, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to a total of 20 horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- On October 31, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 407-2208, which vacated Order Nos. 407-1794, 407-1825, and 407-1826 and established an approximate 1,360acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands and approved up to a total of 20 horizontal wells within the unit for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.
