On February 28, 2018, ConocoPhillips Company (Operator No. 19160) and its wholly owned subsidiary Burlington Resources Oil & Gas LP (Operator No. 26580) (together, "COPC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation:
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Blue 3-65 32-33 1H and the Blue 3-65 33-32 5H_D (API Nos. Pending) ("Wells").
- 3) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On October 31, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-89 which, among other things, established 18 approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands including the Application Lands, and approved to drill up to two horizontal wells in each unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- On September 15, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-535 which, among other things, 1) vacated two approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units established by Order No. 535-89 for Sections 32 and 33, Township 3 South, Range 65 West, 6th P.M.; and 2) established an approximate 1,280-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit for

Sections 32 and 33, Township 3 South, Range 65 West, 6th P.M. and approve up to two horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

• On October 27, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-578 which, among other things, pooled all interests in an approximate 1,280-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit established for Sections 32 and 33, Township 3 South, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, and subjected any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Blue 3-65 32-33 Well. The Blue 3-65 32-33 Well was never drilled on the Application Lands.
