APPLICATION

On March 1, 2018, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Subject additional parties to Order No. 407-1997, which pooled all interests in an approximate 480-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing unit on the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- 2) Providing that the Commission's order subjecting additional parties to Order No. 407-1997 is made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Simpson FD 16-382HN Well (API No. 05-123-44219) in the wellbore spacing unit for the development of the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.
- 3) Providing that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of a horizontal well are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to § 34-60-116(6) and (7), C.R.S., and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof with respect to the horizontal well drilled to develop the Niobrara Formation in the wellbore spacing unit comprising the Application Lands.
- 4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On May 1, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1997 which pooled all interests in an approximate 480-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, and subjected any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Simpson FD 16-382HN Well.
