<u>APPLICATION</u>

On March 1, 2018, Crestone Peak Resources Operating LLC (Operator No. 10633) ("Crestone Peak" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 480-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve up to eight horizontal wells within the approximate 480-acre drilling and spacing unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
- 2) Provide that the productive interval of any horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and not less than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well within the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 3) Authorize up to one new well pad within the unit, subject to Rule 318A or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 4) Find that the approximate 480-acre drilling and spacing unit for the development of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations underlying the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Codell and Niobrara Formations in the Application Lands.
- 5) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area,
Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. The Application Lands are

within the Greater Wattenberg Area ("GWA") and thus are subject to Rule 318A.

On February 19, 1992 (Amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for vertical and/or directional wells for the production of oil and/or gas from the Codell-Niobrara Formations. The Application Lands are subject to Order No. 407-87 as it applies to the existing vertical and/or directional well development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations on the Application Lands.
