On March 1, 2018 (amended on March 22, 2018), Enerplus Resources (USA) Corporation (Operator No. 10177) ("Enerplus" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Subject additional previously unnoticed parties to Order No. 535-934, which, among other things, established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approved eight horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations.


