APPLICATION

On March 21, 2018, Enerplus Resources (USA) Corporation (Operator No. 10177) ("Enerplus" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Subject additional parties to Order No. 535-774, which established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approved eight horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations; and
- 2) Subject additional parties to Order No. 535-935, which pooled all interests in an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations, including the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Ballyshannon 8-67-26-23N (API No. 05-123-44923) Well, the Benroe 8-67-26-23N (API No. 05-123-44922) Well, the Carrick 8-67-26-23C (API No. 05-123-44925) Well, the Cloghfin 8-67-26-23C (API No. 05-123-44926) Well, the Donegal 8-67-26-23C (API No. 05-123-44919) Well, the Killybegs 8-67-26-23C (API No. 05-123-44928) Well, the Lough Erne 8-67-26-23C (API No. 05-123-44931) Well, and the Sligo 8-67-26-23C (API No. 05-123-44921) Well ("Wells").

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of April 16, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
