On April 12, 2018, HighPoint Operating Corporation (Operator No. 10071) ("HighPoint" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit, established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-0108BS (API No. 05-123-45730), Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-1609B (API No. 05-123-45708) Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-1724B (API No. 05-123-45711), Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-3225B (API No. 05-123-45715), Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-3340B (API No. 05-123-45703), Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-4841B (API No. 05-123-45706), Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-4956B (API No. 05-123-45729); and Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-6457BN (API No. 05-123-45727) ("Wells").

On April 27, 1988, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A. was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A. was again amended to, among other things, address drilling of horizontal wells. The Application Lands are subject to Rule 318A.

 On May 1, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1977, which, among other things, established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and authorized the drilling of up to 16 horizontal wells for production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.
