On April 12, 2018, Ephphatha, LLC (Operator No. 10282) ("Ephphatha" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 200-acre drilling and spacing unit in the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Dry Creek UT HD 31 #1A (Pilot Hole) Well (API No. 05-107-06175) ("Well").

- Rule 318.a. of the Commission Rules provides a well to be drilled 2,500 feet or greater shall be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply, unless authorized by the Commission upon hearing. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule.
- On April 12, 2018, Applicant filed an application to establish an approximate 200-acre drilling and spacing unit for portions of Sections 29, 30, 31, and 32, Township 6 North, Range 88 West, 6th P.M., and approve one vertical, directional, or horizontal well for production from the Niobrara Formation, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, and require the productive intervals of the

wellbore of any permitted wells to be no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundary except that it may be located no closer than 300 feet from the southern boundary of the NE½NE½ of Section 31, Township 6 North, Range 88 West, 6th P.M., and no closer than 300 feet from the eastern boundary of the NW½SW½ of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 88 West, 6th P.M., without exception from the Director.
